

ACRYLIC CARE AND CLEANING

It is important to use the proper cleaning solution to keep your art and furniture looking beautiful. We use and recommend Novus Polishes. These are available in many hardware stores, as well as through H. Studio. Please let us know if you would like to include recommended polishes with your order.

There are two kinds of Novus Polishes. One is for light daily use, and the other is a heavier cream that provides a polishing protective layer. When cleaning, wipe gently with a soft cloth. Also be sure to apply enough cleaner to actual acrylic and to the cloth.

Like all fine art, keep H. Studio artwork away from direct sunlight. Heat from the light creates stresses between the different types of acrylic [i.e. darker and lighter colors]. Sunlight also contains ultra violet rays which damage the joints and surfaces. This problem can be alleviated through use of our recommended products, and a monthly application of Novus Cream Polish will create a thin barrier between the artwork and harmful elements.

Caution: Do not use window cleaning fluids, scouring compounds, gritty cloths, household scouring compounds, lacquer thinner, benzene, leaded or ethyl gasoline or strong solvents such as alcohol, acetone, or carbon tetra chlorine. Keep away from excess heat or open flame.

In the event that damage due to negligence does occur, H. Studio will, at the owner's expense, be happy to restore to the best of our expertise any product we offer.

WATERFALLS

Wipe the surface with a soft, non-abrasive cloth together with an acrylic or plastic cleaner. Do not use window cleaners, solvents, or ammonia based cleaners.

H. Studio warrants the pump and light transformers for a period of one year after purchase date. Model MR16, 35-Watt, 120 Volt Halogen replacement light bulbs can be purchased at any local hardware store. Original pump or transformer must be returned for repair without exception to: H. Studio, 8640 Tamarack Ave., Sun Valley, CA 91352.

RUGS

The best way to ensure a long life for your rug is to vacuum regularly and spot clean with a mild soap. You may also have your rug professionally cleaned. Rotate your rug every six months to avoid paths and dirt trails from daily foot traffic. Combined with regular vacuuming, this will ensure your rug's lasting elegance and distribute gradual wear evenly over the entire surface.

SPOT CLEANING

Always apply cleaning solutions to a small, inconspicuous area of the rug first. Blot the rug with a damp white cloth. If color transfers, the treatment should be avoided.

1. If the stain is liquid, blot out as much as you can with a clean cloth, pressing firmly all around the spill to absorb as much liquid as possible.
2. If the stain is from a solid material, scrape up as much as you can with a dull-edged utensil.
3. Dip a cloth into a suitable cleaning solution and wipe the area delicately, working from the outer edge to the center of the spot. Turn the cloth frequently so it is always clean, and do not let the rug become excessively wet. Repeat until the spot is removed.
4. Dry the carpet by weighing down a half inch pad of tissues or cloth to absorb the moisture.
5. After the carpet is dry, gently brush pile into place.
